The four-year-old class had a great time celebrating Thanksgiving with a Friendship Feast. A BIG thank you to William's mom for coming in to help. We started December getting ready for Grandparents' Day by making chocolate covered pretzels. A BIG thank you to Easton's Mom Mom for coming in to help with that! The Grandparents had fun with their grandkids and helped them make a Christmas ornament. We prepared for Christmas by making a Christmas Countdown Chain, Christmas Counting Book and reading lots of good books for the holiday. Our last Show and Tell for 2018 was 10 items of Christmas. What fun it was to see what everyone brought in to share.

We started off the New Year by making 2019 headbands and decorating the After Christmas Tree with treats for wild animals. Next, we learned the letter I, created ice cream cones and experimented with ice turning into water as it melts and reveals a surprise. For letter B week we will discuss bears and make biscuits. Vegetables and violins will be the focus of letter V week. We will accept soup cans the third week of this month to donate to a local food bank during Soup Week. To end January we will talk about the letter M and make mittens.

MUSIC & SPANISH CLASSES

During the months of November and December we had fun singing Christmas songs and ringing jingle bells in music class. We also enjoyed listening to holiday music and moving to the different musical sounds in the toy shop. We loved learning songs for the Christmas program and had a great time performing for our family and friends. It was so good to see everyone enjoying themselves. In the New Year we will explore different instrument families including woodwinds, strings, brass and percussion.
